ITEM 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Borchardt.

ITEM 2. PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

ITEM 3. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATION TO SEEK REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATION'S FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AS RELATED TO THE PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE KRUSE CENTER ON THE BRENHAM CAMPUS

Mr. Richard O'Malley, executive director for facilities, planning and construction, responded to questions from the board. Mr. Toubin inquired about the budget of the project. He pointed out that the last few projects have come in under budget. Mr. O'Malley told the board that he will keep the board upto-date on the budget for the project as the design and bid process progresses. A committee will be formed to review RFQ's for professional services as related to the planning, design, and construction of the Kruse Center on the Brenham Campus.

On a motion by Dr. Boehm, seconded by Mr. Lange, the board voted to award a construction contract to Harrison Alarm, Inc. for \$99,545 in reference to Bid #919 "Fire Alarm Replacements" for the Brenham Campus, as presented by the administration.

ITEM 5. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR BID #920 "IRRIGATION & LANDSCAPING THE OVERFLOW PARKING LOT" ON THE BRYAN CAMPUS

Mr. O'Malley responded to questions from the board. He reviewed the bid process.

On a motion by Mrs. Miller, seconded by Mr. Toubin, the board voted to award a construction contract to Texas Landscape Creations for \$156,081.38 in reference to Bid #920 "Irrigation & Landscaping on the overflow parking lot" on the Bryan Campus, as presented by the administration.
