Song or Album: Music can be listed differently, depending on the container (larger source that contains smaller works) used. Generally, citations begin with the artist’s name, but they can be listed by composers or performers. Otherwise, list composer or performer information after the album title. Put individual song titles in quotation marks. Albums (longer works) are italicized. Provide the name of the recording manufacturer followed by the publication date. If information such as record label or name of album is unavailable from your source, do not list the information.
